Class Description:

Learn how to paint a close-up of your pet or favorite animal in pastel. We will be using the technique that Sally uses for painting her commissioned pet portraits.

Bring a photo of your favorite pet or animal (blown up to 8 1/2 X 11).....we will be painting on a 9" x 12" size and this paper will be available on class day for a minimal cost. We will provide foam boards to tape the sanded paper to and some photos if you do not have anything in particular that you would like to paint.

Supply List:

NuPastels, whatever you have or a basic set is fine

Soft Pastels, any brand, basic set

Sewing gauge (for measuring details)

Fixative (if desired)

Spray bottle of alcohol

Exacto knife (for sharpening pastels)

White artist tape or blue painters tape 1/2"

Pastel pencils in neutrals (optional)

Cheap, stiff small round and fan paintbrushes

Clear gloves, if desired

8 1/2 x 11 blown up (chest up only, no bodies, legs, etc.) picture of the animal they want to paint.

We will have the 9x12 Colorfix sanded papers for students to BUY @ cost in different neutral colors for this project and more if you want to buy extra.

We will be providing foam boards to tape the sanded paper to, blown up photos in case someone forgets to bring, and other items to use, blenders and such.
